Rules of the Tournament

1. This tournament will be called the Holiday Lanes Spring Fling Youth Tournament.
2. USBC rules will govern and will be strictly enforced.
3. Entry Fee will be \$15 per person (Lineage \$10, Trophy Fund \$5).
4. Age Brackets for the participants will be 5-10, 11-14, & 15-19.
5. Check in will begin at 11:00am and entries close promptly at 11:30am, May 2, 2010. After entry fee has been received by tournament director, entry fee cannot be refunded.
6. The tournament director has the right to reject / turn away any entry application after posted deadline date and time.
7. No one will be allowed to compete in the tournament without paid entry fee.
8. Entering averages will be the 2008-2009 USBC yearbook average. If no 2008-2009 yearbook average, then the current 2009-2010 USBC average will be used. If the student is a High School Varsity Bowler, the high school average may be used. If none of the above, then bowler must use 200 average.
9. Tournament handicap will be based on 100% of 220.
10. All averages must be verified prior to entering tournament. Bowlers are responsible for verification of average at check-in. If the average on the entry form/scoring document is lower than the bowler's actual average and the bowler does not make the necessary corrections prior to bowling, the bowler will be disqualified.
11. Unsportsmanlike conduct and/or disorderly behavior will not be tolerated!
If a bowler commits such an action, he or she will be immediately remanded to the Youth Director for consideration. Any turns of bowling missed due to this action will result in a score of zero until the individual returns to his or her normal place in turn. A bowler who has repeated infractions will be disqualified from the tournament.
12. All bowlers shall wear suitable bowling attire in the form of collared sports shirts, dress slacks, skirts or walking shorts. School attire is appropriate. No short shorts will be allowed. Bowlers may not wear hats, caps or mock turtleneck shirts during tournament competition. No head gear may be worn during competition (i-Pods, radios, etc.) Cell phones are not allowed in the settee area.
13. The Tournament Director and the Youth Director will validate all bowled scores prior to announcement of the winning participants..
14. Trophies will be awarded for the 3 highest cumulative scores in the 3 age brackets and the overall winner's name will be inscribed on the Holiday Lanes Spring Fling Trophy which will be displayed at the showcase entrance to Holiday Lanes bowling center.
